## How to join the HBF

1. Read The HBF Mission statement – (**Membership menu**)
2. If interested read the club constitution but if you wish to register a car through the club you should be familiar with section 6 regarding compliance to RMS regulations for use of the vehicle– **Membership menu**
3. Down load and complete a Membership Application form (**membership menu**) and send a copy by email to the club email address
4. Pay the appropriate fee, either using the web site Paypal facility – (**pay for a subscription in the membership menu**)
  - a. or direct to the club account at Newcastle permanent

The membership application form and payment may be sent to the club PO Box at Greenhills but processing usually takes little longer as the PO Box is not cleared daily.
5. Download and complete a vehicle registration for each vehicle you wish to register through the club (**membership menu**) send copies of these forms with the application form
  - a. Vehicle registration forms can be submitted at any time.
